

## From 1 January 2010, child and beneficiary ten trip tickets will no longer be accepted on GO Wellington buses.

### If you currently use a child or beneficiary ten trip ticket please note:

- From Monday 12 October 2009 these ten trip tickets will no longer be sold.
- You can use your ten trip tickets up to and including 31 December 2009.
- We will also refund any value remaining on your ten trip ticket. Simply complete the refund form on the back of this leaflet.
- Refunds will be accepted until 30 June 2010.
- Children can now pay by Snapper and get 20%\* off the cash price of a single child fare.

**Beneficiary Permit holders can still get their discounted cash fare onboard but must show the valid permit to the driver.**
